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## Welcome and settling in

We are pleased to have welcomed our new children and families to nursery as well as our returners. It is great to see the children settling in to nursery life. Please note that every child and family have a key person, please do connect with them as this is your first point of contact if you have any questions, queries or need any information.

## **Clothing**

Please ensure your children are dressed in appropriate clothing for the weather, waterproofs and a winter hat for outdoor learning. We access the outdoor classroom in all weathers. Please ensure all children's clothes are labelled with names in.

As children have access to many messy play activities on a daily basis, please bring your child in old clothes. Dress your child in clothes that support independence when toileting e.g. jogging bottoms rather than clothes with buttons. Please provide spare clothes and personal care items like nappies and wipes in your child's bag and store on your child's peg.

#### Attendance and punctuality at Nursery

Attending every session means 100% attendance and ensures your child has full access to our curriculum. Missing 10 sessions per year is 95% attendance. Missing 30 sessions is 85% attendance which means a child has missed 6 weeks or half a term of school by the end of the year.

#### **Accidents and Illness:**

It is important that you let nursery know if your child has an accident or injury at home, or if they have been unwell. Nursery will also share any accidents or injuries. An accident form will be given out at the end of the session and if your child has a head bump a telephone call home will be completed.

Following an episode of sickness or diarrhoea do not bring your child to Nursery for 48 hours after the last episode. This is to ensure the health and safety of all the children. Call school on the first day of absence on 0121 675 4617.

#### **Medical Conditions**

Please inform your key person if your child has a medical condition or an allergy so we can do a care plan to keep your child safe, or if there have been any recent changes to their medication.

## **Parking**

No parent parking is available on our main site or Dyson Gardens. Please do not park on the zig zag lines. Please do not walk through car parks, please use designated paths for safety.

## Being Healthy - Snack time and lunch time

## Every Child has the Right to the best possible Health & Education

We encourage all children to bring a piece of fruit to nursery each day to access at snack time. Children have daily access to water throughout the day and healthy snack time. We encourage children to try new fruits daily. Milk is given out at the end of each session for children to take home. Only Water will be given at nursery.

For children that attend all day there are two options:

- 1. A healthy packed lunch prepared at home should include the following types of foods everyday:
- A starchy food such as bread, rice, pasta, potatoes, or couscous.
- At least 1 portion of fruit or vegetables, ideally 2.
- A calcium-rich food such as milk, cheese, yoghurt, or fromage frais.
- A food such as meat, fish, eggs, or beans these contain protein and iron.
- A drink of plain water.

 All children who stay for lunch have an opportunity to try a healthy hot school meal. We also provide a vegetable finger food platter to complement school dinners and packed lunches.

You can play with your child and gain ideas of how you can support your child's creativity at home too.

## **Coffee Morning / Afternoons**

A number of coffee morning and afternoons will be advertised this term. Please join us for a coffee and a cake, here you can make new friends, get nursery updates and have time to yourself to nurture your own well-being.

#### **Nursery places**

We still have places available for 2, 3 and 4 year olds for a January 2025.

#### **Government funding**

From September 2025 we plan to accept children under 2 that meet the criteria for 30 hours. We will also be exploring wrap around and school holiday provision. Please register your interest now with the school office as places will be limited.

## **School Applications**

#### When can your child start school?

Children in Birmingham can start school (reception) in the September after their fourth birthday. **Example:** If your child was born between **1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021,** they will be able to start school in September 2025.

#### Responsibility for applying online

The responsibility for applying online for a child to start reception class remains solely with parents or carers. Our office manager Alisha will be holding drop in sessions to support parents to make the application on Fridays. If you would like support please attend one of these sessions and book in with Alisha.

## When to apply

Parents can apply for a place in the Autumn of the year before their child turns 4. You must apply for a place before 15<sup>th</sup> January 2025
